CALL TO ORDER / ROLL CALL FOR SPECIAL MEETING

The special meeting was called to order by Mayor Peluso at 3:00 p.m. in the Multi-Purpose Room of the Newport Municipal Building at 998 Monmouth Street. The meeting was opened with a moment for silent invocation and the mayor led the Pledge of Allegiance.

In attendance were: Commissioner Beth Fennell, Commissioner Thomas Guidugli, Commissioner John Hayden, Commissioner Frank Peluso, and Mayor Jerry Peluso. Also in attendance were: City Manager Thomas Fromme, Police Chief Thomas Collins and City Clerk Amy Able.
